



Men's League 2018

Men's league begins Tuesday May 8th. (Weather Permitting)

Thursday, May 31st will be a Men's League Drop in. Players will be mixed up and play for fun. No points for this night.

Cost is \$650/team entered.

Cost for Season long Snips is \$420/ team

Snips are not Mandatory. \$3.00 per player to enter. \$1.00 goes to long putt snips, \$1.00 to Closest to the Pin snip and \$1.00 goes to 50/50. You can pay as you go or your team can pre pay for the year.

This is a flat fee and needs to be paid by May 31st. Any money not paid by this date means that team will forfeit points each week until paid in full.

The cost includes;

- \$330 - 2 Meals - Scramble nights - Up to 10/team/night.
- \$110 - Scramble Prize Money
- \$210 - Playoff Prize Pool.
- Further break down of the prize money is available upon request.

Men's League 9 holes will take place on Tuesday and Thursday – shotgun start at 6:30pm.

Weekly Formats

Each week will be rotation of 3 different formats Stroke play, match play and 2 man scramble as you play against a different team each week. Each week you will play with one member of your team along with 2 members of your opposing team. Points are awarded to each match won or tied and your team will be ranked in our standings depending on your amount of points each week. All matches are played with Handicaps.

Handicaps

A true RCGA is the average score of your 10 best rounds out of your last 20 rounds. We do not have enough stroke play rounds to do this so we keep a Men's league 9 hole handicap. It is determined by the average of your last 4 rounds played in league.

All matches need to be filled out and turned in on the score sheet. All Score sheets need to be turned in by 9:15 or points will be not count for that week.

Scrambles (2)

Scramble Nights are May 31st and September 5th

- Everyone Plays White Tees.
- 2 drives from each player for a foursome
- 2 drives from each player and 1 from the low handicap for Fivesome.
- All players on your team are welcome to play

-Play BOTH groups together – in groups of 8, 9 or 10.

Gimmee's are to be given inside the rubber on a standard putter.
